THE ROLE

We are actively seeking a dynamic individual to join our national, regionally-based team. In this role, you will lead on delivering high quality production services support to feature film and HETV productions looking to film in the North and Midlands. Your primary responsibility will be to establish and foster collaborative partnerships with an extensive network of local and regional partners, both public and private, to ensure filming can take place seamlessly and efficiently.

Your role will extend beyond logistical support, encompassing implementing best practices, troubleshooting, and actively supporting the development of local filming offers by closely collaborating with local authority and film office partners. We are looking for a capable professional who can excel in delivering production support to the film & TV industry, all while enabling partners to maximise the benefits of production activity. If you have a passion for championing the North and Midlands, and possess excellent communication and interpersonal skills, we invite you to apply and contribute to the success of Filming in England.

MAIN AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- Manage an industry focussed production liaison service to filmmakers and companies looking to film across the North and Midlands, providing comprehensive support to feature film & HETV drama productions.
- Establish and maintain information on all feature film & HETV filming across the North and Midlands, expanding our network of partners & promoting the benefits of the Filming in England Partnership.





- Collaborate with regional, city, county and local film office partners across the North and Midlands to meet the needs of industry and realise the ambitions of our partners.
- Build and maintain effective working relationships with Local Authority Filming Partners in the North and Midlands to provide an industry-facing service ensuring film & TV productions receive a filmfriendly welcome.
- Deploy a flexible model of support to Local Authority Filming Partners, combining hybrid online learning and bespoke 1:1 advice, fostering collaboration, and actively supporting efforts to enhance production activities across the North and Midlands.
- Maintain and develop representation of the North and Midlands locations on the National Locations
 Directory. Act as a broker between filmmakers and land, site and property owners, public agencies,
 and utilities, film support and facility companies and scout for locations for projects.
- Develop membership for our Filming in England Partnership and lead the North and Midlands Regional Filming Hub initiatives with support from the wider team.
- Track and accurately record filming activity across the North and Midlands using Reel-Scout project and reporting module, monitor production activity and levels closely and contribute to reports to meet funder requirements.
- Coordinate with Production Liaison Manager for the East and South East and Production Liaison Manager for the South West to effectively deliver National representation to industry.
- Co-ordinate and deliver online location portfolios in response to National Location Enquiries for the North and Midlands, and other regions where necessary.
- Collaborate with the wider team to support marketing initiatives and continuous brand building, including updating website information, success stories related to productions across the English regions as well supporting Filming in England quarterly Regional Connect events when they are hosted in the North and Midlands
- Collaborate with other departments of Creative UK to ensure that partners are aware of our broader services to the creative industries, ensuring a joined-up approach to enquiries internally where appropriate.
- Seek sponsorship or additional revenue opportunities to support delivery and ensure any agreed outputs for funding are met; liaise closely with the Head of Production Services and Partnerships Manager when opportunities arise.
- Develop Creative UK's commitment to equal opportunities and promote non-discriminatory practices in all aspects of work undertaken.
